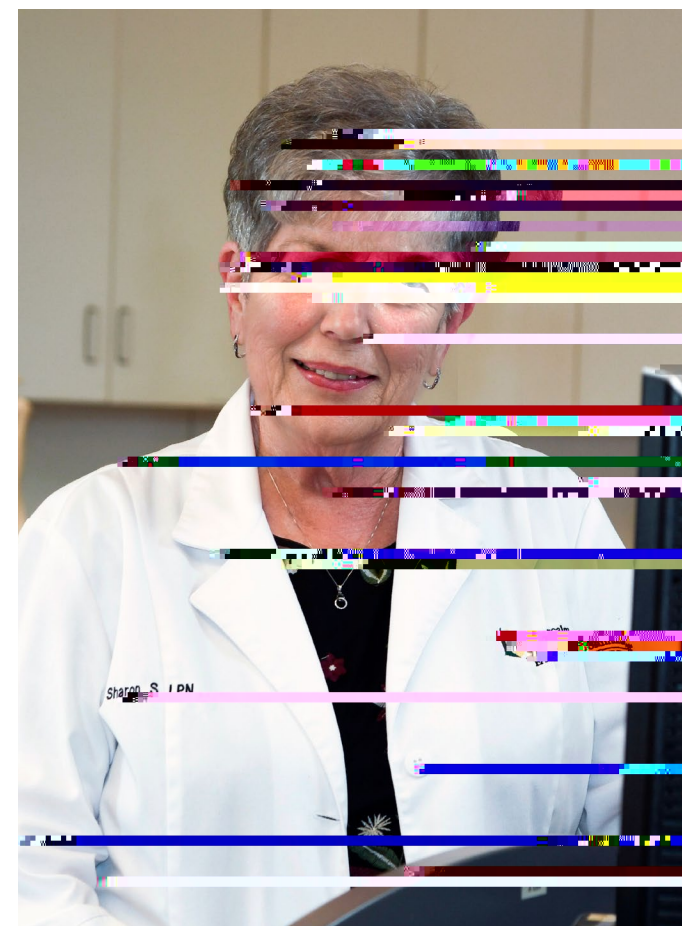


FACULTY FOCUS
