ased on workplace demand and industry projections, a continued focus of the college during this past year was to enhance and create high-value programming tied to progressive advancements in a variety of career areas, as well as full lling customized training needs for its business and industry partners.

Curriculum and equipment enhancements to support programming in industrial technology, industrial automation maintenance, technical drafting and design, digital arts, nursing and business are just a few examples of how MCC is working to prepare students for careers in high-demand, high-wage elds.

In collaboration with K-12 partners, and business, industry and health organizations, MCC is continuing its e orts to support a countywide, coordinated focus on career exploration, advising and development, where students receive needed support as they investigate and develop their unique interests.
