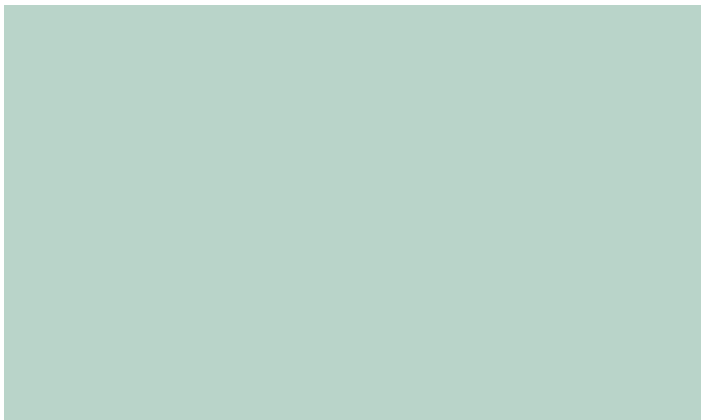


Skilled Trades, A.A.S.

Description: This innovative program is designed for individuals who already hold a current journeyman card that is recognized by the State of Michigan, or the U.S. Department of Labor. Students who provide appropriate documentation verifying their journeyman status will receive 29 credits for SKTR295. Students must then complete all general education coursework at MCC, and as many suggested electives as necessary to earn at least 60 credits.

Completion Time: 1 Year plus journeyman or Skilled Trades Certificate.
